Learning Means the World

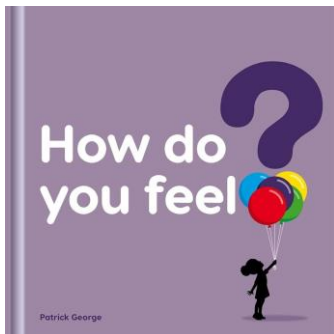
We have begun to design and make a fairy bag.

We are focusing on the core elements that a sentence needs: a capital letter at the beginning, finger spaces between words, and punctuation at the end.
