We were so pleased that so many parents were able to come to the Open Morning on Wednesday. The children really enjoyed sharing their learning with you!

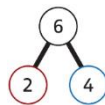
What have we been learning about this week:

Learning Means the World

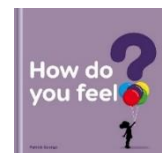


This is a part-whole model. It shows that 6 is the whole. 2 is a part. 4 is a part.
