In Geography we have sorted physical and human features and identified some human and physical features in Ripon.

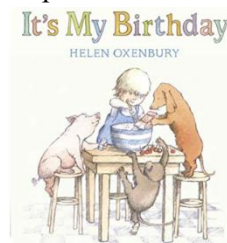
## Maths
