Learning Means the World

This week we learnt about the Greek mathematician Archimedes and his principle of displacement. We experimented by dropping stones into a tub of water and observing what happened to the water level. We also heard a fable from the Greek storyteller Aesop called 'The Crow and the Pitcher' in which the crow used Archimedes Principle to get a drink.



Maths

This week we have been solving problems that include addition and subtraction. We read the questions carefully to decide which operation we needed to do. We then calculated using the column method.

Spelling

We have been looking at the suffixes '-ness' and '-ful'. We experimented by adding these to a range of root words. We discussed the spelling rules and then independently included these in sentences.
