Learning Means the World



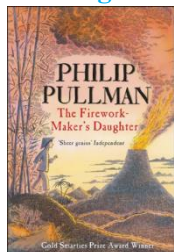
Last week we completed our science unit 'May the Force be with you' which focussed on forces. We used our knowledge of magnets to design and create a game.
