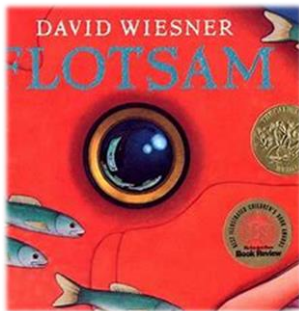
Maths
