What have we been learning about this week?

Learning Means the World

We are very excited about our new unit, learning about the history of Ripon. We have been working in groups to develop a leaflet and guided tour of the city and its key landmarks. We have researched these landmarks, but also used our own knowledge to add a personal touch to our tour scripts.



Maths

Our focus these last couple of weeks has been around geometry of shapes. We have been finding the perimeter and area of rectilinear shapes and of triangles, and also measuring and recognising angles.

English

Our new English text is non-fiction, and provides a series of fascinating animal facts, focused around the collective nouns for each group of animals. We have been looking at how this text uses a range of sentence openers to structure the writing in different ways, and we have 'magpied' some of these openers to use in our own writing.

Guided Reading

We are really enjoying reading 'Holes' and have been using inference and deduction skills to explore the text in depth.

We have started focusing on throwing and batting skills in rounders. We have been using skills that we have developed over the course of the year to improve our techniques.
