Our focus in Swale: Presentation

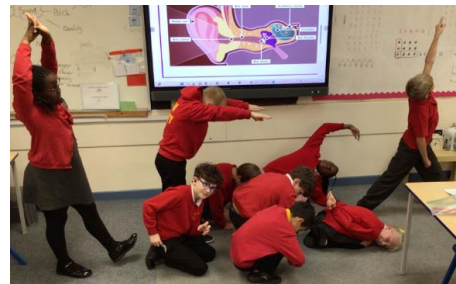
## Learning Means the World



Through our unit "Picture our Planet" we have been doing some very exciting geography which took us to the woodland area to create some fantastic 'small worlds' of Brazil and Scotland. We also took part in our own Scottish Highland Games and some traditional Scottish Dancing.

Music has also been a big focus in Learning Means the World and we have been identifying texture in Scottish and Samba music and comparing both types of music. We also created our own call and response rhythms.
