Learning Means the World



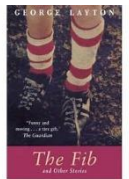

PE

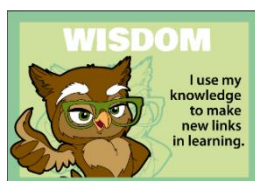
We have continued with our learning in Tag Rugby and badminton.
