We are delighted that you have continued to choose Holy Trinity for your child's learning journey. Our school is unique: each day opens up horizons of hope, aspiration and joy within the city of Ripon; our ethos embodies 'life in all its fullness' and is core to the provision and nurture we offer our children and their families.

Everyone at The Federation of Holy Trinity Church of England Schools is called and committed to their role in educating the children of the future. We recognise that the time children spend with us is precious therefore we see it as our mission to inspire a love of learning. I am privileged to work alongside extremely dedicated staff who strive to equip every child with exciting, challenging and memorable educational experiences during their time with us.

As you will be aware, currently the Federation is planning significant changes to the organisation of the two schools within the Federation. We believe these are exciting and will enhance the educational experience for our pupils. Leeds Diocesan Learning Trust are proposing to merge Holy Trinity Church of England Infant School and Holy Trinity Church of England Junior School creating a new Holy Trinity Church of England Primary School. Holy Trinity Church of England Primary School will be based within a single premises on the current junior site. The new school will include pupils from Reception through to Year 6 (ages 4 -11) whilst continuing to provide nursery class provision for children aged 3-4, as the Infant School currently does. During your child's transition to the Junior School, we will work together to develop and secure strong, effective home-school partnerships. Transferring to a new phase of education is an exciting time and one which provides exciting new challenges and opportunities. We aim to ensure that transition is a smooth one so that your child quickly settles into their new environment. In addition to regular visits to the junior site for PE and Collective Worship, we have various opportunities for yourself and your child to familiarise yourselves with the site. Our caterers Hutchisons will be inviting Year2 and their parents for lunch at the junior school after half term.
