## A Message from the Headteacher

The Friends are delighted to announce that an amazing total of £3,387.45 was raised! This is a fabulous start to our new modular library - watch out for new furniture arriving soon!

**Amalgamation Updates** It is hard to believe we have only been on one site for just 4 weeks. All classes are continuing to be settled and working well. Staff are finding being on one site has strengthened the team which has a positive impact on teaching and learning. As children have adjusted to the new breaktimes we have been able to relaunch Zone Rangers and introduce a range of playground equipment and activities. In our recent survey parents fed back that the end of the school day, the staggered finish times currently mean parents have a 10 minute wait. To change the timings of the school day we will need to launch a consultation with staff, parents and local stakeholders. We would also need to adjust staff working hours to reflect any changes. School leaders will continue to monitor this and review if we need to review timings in the new year.
