It's been so lovely to back in class, and I've been really impressed with how so many of the class are trying so hard. The class have been very welcoming to our new member of the class.

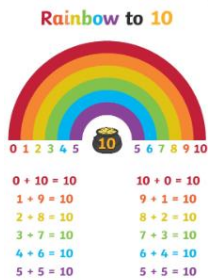
What have we been learning about this week:

Maths

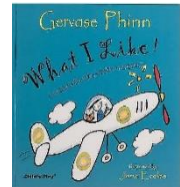


We have now moved onto our new unit, addition within 10. We are learning about different addition strategies, and will be used physical resources, number line and our knowledge of number facts to help us to add.
