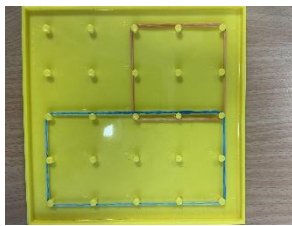

In our new Learning Means the World theme 'Law and Order' we have been thinking about consequences of choices we make. Children developed a mini-teach activity where they taught another group a new skill!

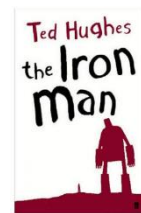
## Maths



We have started a new topic looking at measuring area. Children have been exploring different ways to measure the area of rectilinear shapes including using a peg board and using different shapes.

## Reading

We have started exploring our new reading book "The Iron Man" by Ted Hughes and children have been making predictions on what they think the story might be about based upon the front cover and an excerpt from the text.



## Writing

Our new text "Blue John" has provided children with the inspiration to create their own setting descriptions. We have been using expanded noun phrases, powerful verbs and similes to write descriptive setting descriptions about the bottom of the ocean.

## PE

Our new unit is Dance and we have been learning how work co-operatively together, with developing awareness of the impact of consequences of decisions. This has been introduced with a fast paced game that required group co-operation, followed by activities that allowed children to think about the rights that come with responsibilities by working closely with partners guiding and controlling their movements.
