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Collective Worship

Next week in collective worship we are starting our Advent journey.

Advent, (from Latin adventus, "coming"), in the Christian church calendar, the period of preparation for the celebration of the birth of Jesus Christ at Christmas and also of preparation for the Second Coming of Christ. This week we will be lighting our first Advent candle which is the candle of Expectation or Hope. This candle is sometimes called the Prophet's Candle.

The Big Ambition

Last week I had the privilege of attending a presentation by The Children's Commissioner for England, Dame Rachel



de Souza. Dame Rachel spoke passionately about her role, especially about her duty to promote and protect the rights of all children, with particular regard to children who are living away from home or receiving social care services. As part of her speech, she shared that her priority is to listen to children across the country, to hear about their lives and champion their voices. Dame Rachel has launched The Big Ambition: a national survey of children and young people across England. The Big Ambition aims to hear from children across England on what they think is important! In the lead up to the next General Election, the Children's Commissioner wants to take children's thoughts, opinions and ideas to decisionmakers, to make sure that the Government hears young people's voices on what

they think needs to be done to make children's lives better in England.

The survey has gone to schools across England so the commissioner can start to hear from children and young people aged from 6 to 18. Parents are also being encouraged to complete the survey for those who may need additional support or on behalf of younger children (under 6) to make sure the needs of early years children are represented too.

The Big Ambition survey will be open until Friday 15th December.

Safeguarding

What is safer recruitment?

Safer recruitment is a set of practices we follow at Holy Trinity to help make sure all staff and volunteers are suitable to work with children and young people. It is a vital part of creating a safe and positive environment and making a commitment to keep children safe from harm. Safer recruitment should be a continuing process of improvement for every school, club, business or organisation whose work or services involve contact with children. The Federation has a robust Safer Recruitment Policy which we adhere to and evidence when recruiting any new member to the team.

All schools are required to hold a Single Central Record. The single central record must cover the following people:

- all staff (including supply staff, and teacher trainees on salaried routes) who work at the school. In colleges, this means those providing education to children; and
- for independent schools, including academies and free schools, all members of the proprietor body (this includes members and trustees).

Staff

"Staff" means any person working at the school whether under a contract of employment, under a contract for services or otherwise than under a contract and includes a person working as a volunteer' The Education (Independent School Standards) (England) (Amendment) Regulations

The information that must be recorded in respect of staff (including teacher trainees on salaried routes) is whether the following checks have been carried out or certificates obtained, and the date on which each check was completed/certificate obtained.

The school Safeguarding governor checks the Single Central Record termly.


