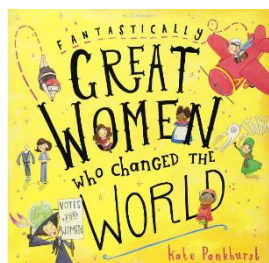


Swale Class News
