Learning Means the World

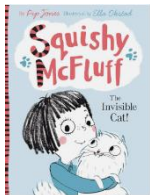

Maths

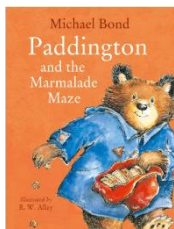
We have thrown ourselves into being multiplication masters and have been practising multiplying 3 digit numbers by 1 number. We have now started a focus on division of numbers with remainders.
