What have we been learning about this week?

Learning Means the World

We have started our new unit 'True Crime' which focuses on our historical investigation skills to look at The Pendle Witch trials. We have particularly enjoyed using drama this week to look at some of the different people accused of being witches.

Maths

Our Maths learning has been challenging this week as we have got to grips with multiplying fractions by an integer and multiplying fractions by fractions. Well done to children for their resilience and making links in their learning.

Reading

We have continued our using our class novel War Horse (which is now getting incredibly emotional) to answer some questions on inference. We have also looked at a text all about Martin Luther King Junior as Monday was Martin Luther King Day.

Writing

In English we have started a new and exciting tale called 'Antigone'. Children have really enjoyed looking at the different characters and how the story is building up, and again we have used drama to reinforce our learning in this area.

PE

Children have developed their skills of passing and throwing using a chest pass, overhead pass and shoulder pass. They have used these skills whilst playing netball and benchball this week.
