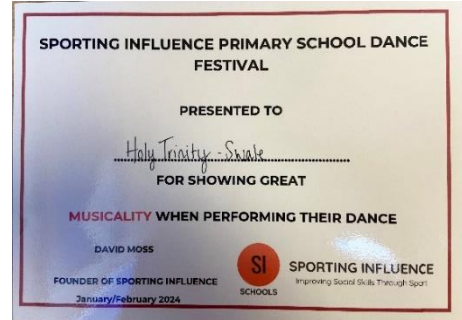


Swale Class News

Learning Means the World

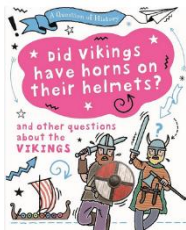
