What have we been learning about this week:

Learning Means the World

We have been learning facts about the lives of Queen Elizabeth II and Queen Victoria and compared Victorian Times with today.

We also had a Science session where the class helped Professor Jiffy who accidentally shredded his pictures that he needed to make his Book of Exotic Animals. The children worked together and to fix them then classify and sort the animals into groups.

Maths

We have continued learning about numbers to 20 and thinking about their place on a numberline. Comparing numbers, thinking about greater than and less than.

Reading

Our class text is **Naughty Bus** by Jan Oke.

We have enjoyed sharing other stories such as Alice In Wonderland (Ladybird picture books) and Marvin Wanted MORE! By Joseph Theobald, which we found very funny.



Writing

We have been using our text to help us plan our own writing. We worked together to create our own version of the Naughty Bus story and then each wrote a new story – The Cheeky Train.

PE

In our gymnastics, we have worked hard to learn and practise how to rock on different body parts of our bodies and rock using shapes such as the **tuck rock**. Super effort as we performed balances too!

We have been learning about how Christians show they belong to a faith community. We also learned about the Shabbat meal, a way that Jewish people show they belong. We enjoyed a special moment with the table set with candles too and talked about how sharing bread and a drink together felt friendly, caring and special.
