What have we been learning about this week:

Learning Means the World

We have been creating a fantasy world called 'Jangaland', and then creating maps using a key. We have used our compass skills to describe where different landmarks are and have sorted them into human and physical features.

Maths

In Maths we have been looking at subtracting numbers up to 20. We used our classmates to help us find the difference. When Miss Ward stood us in two lines, we could clearly see the difference. We then wrote a number sentence to reflect this. The concept of finding the difference has been tricky, but we have been working really hard!
